On Bank Holiday Monday and on most Saturdays, you can ask for a "Groupsave" ticket on which 4 adults can travel for the price of 2, and up to 4 children for a pound each. Yes – that's your group of 8 to London and back for a total of £101.00, or to Weymouth and back for a total of £36.00

Getting to the station and buying tickets

Melksham Station is situated just off the Bath Road to the north of the town. It's an easy walk from the town centre, and there are cycle racks and free parking there.

There is no ticket office nor ticket machine at Melksham station, which means you can get on the train without a ticket and buy one from the train manager.

There are sometimes low cost advanced fares available online. These tie you to a particular train, and you must have the tickets delivered by post or collect them from a station with a ticket machine before you travel.

A wide range of tickets and fares is available – please check with First Great Western for the most appropriate ticket, and for terms and conditions.

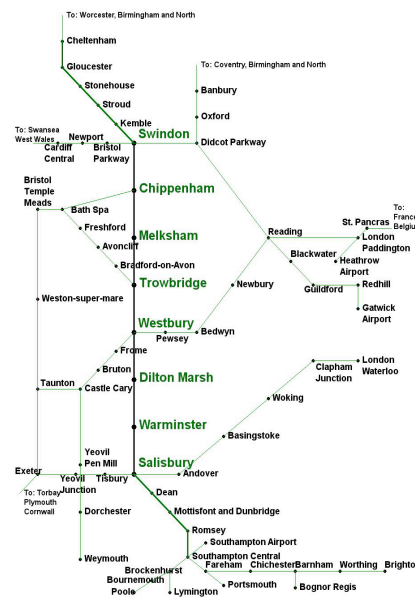

The TransWilts line and connections



This leaflet includes the complete timetable of stopping passenger trains on the section of line between Chippenham and Trowbridge via Melksham.

Additional services run between Chippenham and Swindon, and between Trowbridge and Salisbury.

Some TransWilts trains continue south to Southampton.

Some TransWilts trains run to and from Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa.

About the TransWilts line

The TransWilts railway line links the five largest urban population centres in Wiltshire – Swindon, Salisbury, Chippenham, Trowbridge and Melksham. It also serves Westbury, Warminster, and Dilton Marsh.

There's a limited train service at present – just two trains each way call at Melksham – but background work has been done and that service should rise to eight trains each way per day in the future. This will offer a service every two hours in each direction, and an hourly service to Bristol with a change at Trowbridge or Chippenham.

As well as train service improvements, Wiltshire Council will be improving sustainable station access under the local sustainable transport fund, which will provide real improvements in getting to the station, in facilities there, and in information about train service and connections.

The TransWilts Community Rail Partnership is a co-operation between local government, business, the rail industry and the residents served by the line to bring everyone together in joined up thinking to make the more appropriate service, when it's provided, a great success.
